## *Redington Shores Denies Sanctuary's Bird of Prey Aviary*

### WE CAN BUILD CONDOS, BUT NOT A CAGE FOR THE BIRDS

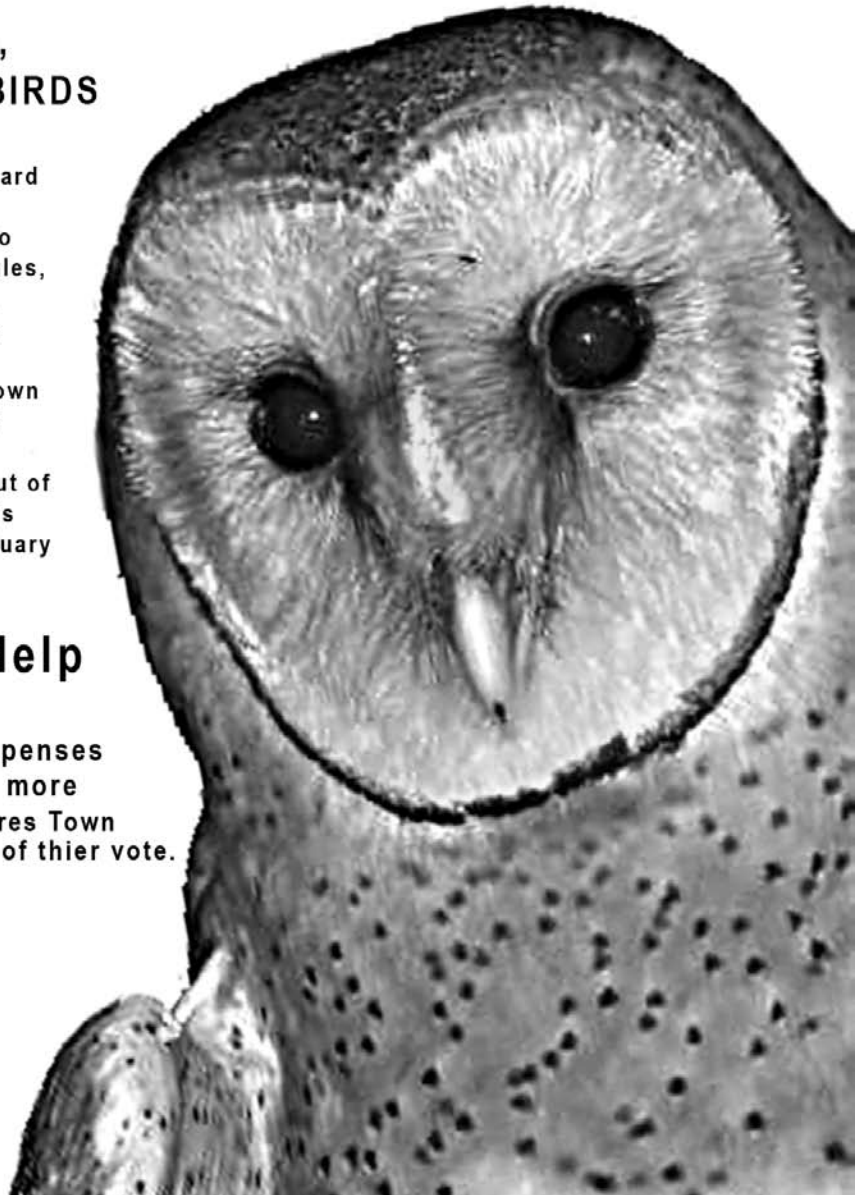
The Redington Shores Planning & Zoning Board approved the Suncoast Seabird Sanctuary's request for a Site Plan variance on Dec. 10 to build an aviary for injured birds of prey: eagles, hawks, ospreys and owls, especially babies. Sadly, the Town Commissioners rejected the variance site plan on Jan. 10, stating the Sanctuary is not a desirable attraction the town wants. Condos are ok, but a cage for injured birds to temporarily rehabilitate is not. Injured birds of prey have to be driven far out of town to other rehabilitation facilities. This is expensive and time consuming for the Sanctuary and its staff and volunteers.
